Lake Shore Public Schools offers Career Technical Education (CTE) programs at Lake Shore High School. These programs are designed to prepare students for a broad range of employment opportunities and continuing education. Follow-up studies conducted on a yearly basis across the state continue to show that the most successful high school graduates were those who took part in a college-prep course of study *and* a CTE program of study. CTE programs are staffed by teachers with specialized training and experience in related business and industry fields. CTE programs enhance a student's learning process with real-world training and the opportunity to prepare for a career and potentially earn college credit.
